

DOCENT APPLICATION

A docent is an educator trained to further the public's understanding of the cultural and natural collections of the Museum. Docents give guided tours of each of the Museum's exhibit halls (Dinosaur, American Indian, and Montana History), as well as our traveling exhibits. Tours are offered to the public, school groups, and group reservations - seniors, adults, or children may be part of a tour group. A docent makes a commitment of at least two years to the educational programs at Museum of the Rockies and participates within ongoing training. Docents are required to give 15 guided tours a year.
